Emergency Shelter

Legal Advocacy

Trained advocates can assist victims with the legal process whether criminal or civil.

We can assist in completing the necessary paperwork when seeking a Domestic Violence Protection Order or Personal Safety Order. We also provide victim advocacy for court proceedings.

Sexual Assault Advocacy

We are available to accompany victims at the hospital to answer questions regarding the medical examination and testing.

We also assist victims if they choose to move forward in the criminal process.

Counseling

We are able to provide both individual and group counseling to victims that have experienced or witnessed abuse.

Elder Abuse Advocacy

We have a specially trained advocate to provide services to victims of elder abuse; including financial exploitation.

Tutoring

We offer educational assistance to clients and their children: including help with homework, test preparation and plans for extra curricular activities.
